- If you lose your Library card and get a replacement you will have to update your library card number on the Libby app. If you have books checked out or on hold call the Library at 208-585-3931 and we can merge your new account number with your old one.
- You can select the lending period for each title you check out. Before you click on Borrow, click on the lending period above it, a new menu will open up letting you choose your lending period. Select the number of days that works for you by clicking on it. FYI: some of our Partner Libraries limit the lending period to 14 days.
- Your library card gives you access to over 5000 magazines in the Libby app. Click on and then click Magazines.
