# Rules for Teen and Adult Winter Reading Bingo 2026

Ages 12+

Each BINGO square has either a book type to read (such as "A Book with a Color in the Title") or a task to do (such as "Read Wrapped in a Blanket"). Cross off the squares as you finish the reading or the task. Each book only counts for one square. For example, if you read an old favorite with a color in the title, you may cross off "old favorite" OR "book with a color in the title."

When you cross off enough squares for a BINGO, bring your card to the front desk.

We will give you a ticket. Write your name and phone number on the ticket and place it in the jar next to the grand prize you would like to try to win!

Repeat for every BINGO you get!

Up and down

Diagonally
